PRAYER FOCUS: This prayer request was posted on the website of the Southern Baptist International Mission Board:

BATONGA OF ZAMBIA (bah-TONG-uh) - The loss of a loved one is exceptionally common among the Plateau BaTonga of the Southern Province of Zambia. They live in a culture of death and dying, whether it is a precious baby who perishes of some mysterious illness or a robust 45 year old who is prematurely taken down by AIDS. Death is an everyday possibility and an unfortunate reality. The Plateau BaTonga are considered to be .1 percent Christian. They are dying daily, lost in their sins and not knowing Jesus Christ as their Savior. There is only one Southern Baptist missionary, newly widowed, who labors among this people group of 654,000. She is also intimately familiar with the anguish of losing a loved one. Please pray that she will boldly and effectively communicate the gospel to the Plateau BaTonga so that they will be snatched from the brink of eternal death. Pray that she will have emotional and spiritual perseverance as she ministers through her unique understanding of grief to those who also grieve.
